

Checking Out

You can check out up to 10 titles. The lending period can vary from title to title.

Your Digital Cart will hold up to 12 titles at a time. Titles are removed from your Digital Cart after 90 minutes so that other users can have the chance to check them out.

Returning & Renewing

Some titles can be returned before they expire. Titles cannot be renewed, but you can check them out again after they expire if they are still available.

Holds

Up to 10 titles can be placed on hold at one time. We'll send you an email when a title becomes available. You have 5 days to check out your hold after we email you notice that it is available.

MESSAGE FROM THE MEMBERSHIP CHAIR

The Friends of the Fallbrook Library are 307 members strong. 196 individuals and businesses hold Life memberships. There are 84 regular annual members and 27 Patron members. 23 of those memberships are new to the organization.

Annual FOFL memberships are good for a year: from May 1 one year to April 30 of the following year. There are two ways to be an annual member: Individual memberships are \$15, Patron memberships are \$25 or more. As a Patron you are giving a little extra to support the Friends.

Beginning February 1, 2013, all new and renewing annual memberships will be good until April 30, 2014. That is three months free!

NEW ART EXHIBITS BRING PEOPLE TO THE LIBRARY.

During September and October the library hosted “¡Siempre Viva! Exposition of Latino Art”. This was the first local exhibition ever featuring Latino art. Outstanding artists from Fallbrook, Southern California and Colombia showed examples of their recent work. A wide variety of styles, media and subjects including imaginative portraiture, realistic and surrealistic depictions of Latino culture, abstract painting and prints, contemporary expressions of Latino mythology, and artistic interpretations of the Latino experience in the United States were included. The artists were Hernando Carrizosa, Carlos Castrejon, Cosme Cordova, Isabel Camacho Diamond, Lori Escalera, Daniel Martinez, Daniel Marquez and Aura Maria Suarez.



The exhibit opened with a reception which featured Latino music, dancing and special Latino food. Attendance was the highest ever for an art opening at the Library and people including the band were reluctant to go home when the reception closed!

ARTFUL STITCH II.....ART QUILTS 4 THE WALL







The contemporary art nature of these pieces emphasizes design including surface techniques – painting, printing and discharge – as well as traditional and innovative stitching.

An opening night reception honoring the artists was held in the library's Community Room on Friday, November 9 from 6 to 8 pm. The exhibit runs through January 3, 2013 and coincides with several other important art quilt shows this fall in the greater San Diego area.








